Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to determine the general health status of nursing students before enrolling in nursing program. In addition, this will help identify students who may not meet the physical standards required to continue and be successful in nursing career.

Policy:

- To be eligible for registration, all students admitted with full, provisional status and attending full or part-time must have a Health Evaluation submitted complete initially.
- Students are to meet health requirements prior to enrollment and clinical activities.
- When a student is readmitted after inactive status, a new Health Evaluation must be performed. The student should obtain the appropriate forms from the Ministry of Health (MOH) clinics.

Procedure:

1. The student will submit a health evaluation report to the admission and registration unit at the Jordan University of Sciences and Technology.
2. The student will receive vaccinations such as hepatitis B vaccine prior to starting clinical
3. Documentation on the status of immunizations will be monitored by the clinical faculty.
4. Failure to submit the relevant documentation of immunization within the scheduled timeframe (2 weeks prior to the start of clinical) may result in a hold on the enrollment process.

Definitions:

Health assessment is the **evaluation** of the **health** status by performing a physical exam after taking a **health** history for the nursing students.
