Zero Emission Vehicles (ZEV) policy on campus: university has one car (zero emission) full electrical and the university employees have 300 cars zero emission) and they charge their electric cars for free.

University sites are cyclist and pedestrian friendly. Many have vehicle-free paths for these users. There is up to 40 km speed limit on all internal roads, , and cycle paths on the public roads. All sites have cycle racks in a variety of designs.

The University encourage cycling by giving permissions to employees and students to bring their bikes to university.

University offers to charge the electrical cars for free to encourage employees to use the electrical cars inside the university.
