About the Course

This two-week course discusses conflicts and cooperation over shared water resources both internationally and nationally. It reflects on processes of water diplomacy and its role in conflict transformation, including lessons from case-studies from the region and beyond. The course provides a broad introduction to water conflict analysis, theories of water conflict and cooperation, as well as overlooked issues interlinked to complex economic, political and diplomatic dynamics. The course will present a theoretical background combined with lessons learned from real examples on water conflict and cooperation, as well as active-learning and dialogue-driven activities through break-out sessions and 'serious' gaming.

Critical Thinking

Participants will learn to analyze water-related conflicts from various angles, considering environmental, gender, political, and economic dimensions.

Regional and Global Perspective

The course will offer insights into transboundary water management in the MENA region, with connections to global issues such as climate change.

Networking

Participants will have the opportunity to connect with experts in the field, fellow participants, and course instructors, fostering a collaborative learning environment.

Field Trips

Participants will engage in two field trips aimed at providing them with practical, real-world insights into water conflict and cooperation dynamics. These excursions are designed to foster a deeper understanding of the complexities surrounding shared water resources.
