

Most frequently asked questions about the undergraduate proficiency exam by students

1. What capabilities does the University Proficiency Test measure and who is responsible for it?

University Proficiency Test measures general qualifications and accuracy expected by Jordanian university graduates for bachelor's degree to see the quality of education outcomes in universities.

It is responsible for Accreditation and Quality Assurance Commission for Higher Education Institution.

2. What is the importance of the University Proficiency Test?

The Test is a compulsory requirement for graduation in accordance with the decision of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.

The graduation procedure cannot be completed without passing it. And the test's Certificate is one of the documents required to apply to the Civil Service Bureau for students with Jordanian citizenship.

3. Is the university proficiency test compulsory?

Yes, the test is a compulsory requirement for graduation in accordance with the decision of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research. The student cannot complete the graduation process and receive the degree until after passing the university proficiency test.

4. What kind of questions does the test provide?

It is a set of paragraphs that measure the general and accurate qualifications expected to be mastered by graduates of Jordanian universities for the bachelor's degree. The general qualifications segment relates to the general skills and knowledge that all university students should master regardless of specialization. while exact qualifications part is about the skills and knowledge to be mastered in each discipline.

5. Who are the students required to take the university proficiency test?

All students expected to graduate, and who have completed the hours and remain in training, take the exam every semester.

6. Is there a make-up test for students who did not attend the official announced university proficiency test?

The Accreditation and Quality Assurance Commission for Higher Education Institution is responsible for deciding and when to hold a make-up for the proficiency test, if any, after calculating the numbers of students who did not take the test at the official date announced.

7. How do I get the University proficiency test certificate?

For students who graduated from the first semester 2018/2019 and beyond, they can obtain the certificate through the student's e-services under the qualification certificate clause. Students who graduated before the first semester 2018/2019 can obtain the certificate through their academic departments.

For additional copies of the certificate, this class of students can check the Deanship of Academic Development and Quality Assurance.

8. What information is required when requesting a lost certificate for students who took the qualification test before the first semester 2018/2019?

When applying for a lost Certificate through the Deanship of Academic Development and Quality Assurance, students are required to provide the Deanship with the university number, name, graduation semester and the semester in which the student submitted the test, telephone number and the Email.

9. Can I apply to the University proficiency test again?

The test instructions do not allow you to take the exam again.
