

Instructions for Membership in University Gym Facilities

Article 1

These instructions shall be called “Instructions for Membership in University Gym Facilities at Jordan University of Science and Technology for the year 2012” and shall be effective from the date of issuance.

Article 2

The following terms and phrases, wherever mentioned in these instructions, shall have the meanings assigned to them unless indicated otherwise:

- **University:** Jordan University of Science and Technology
- **President:** University President
- **Dean’s Office:** Dean of Student Affairs
- **Dean:** Dean of Student Affairs
- **Committee:** Membership Committee formed in accordance with these instructions to review membership applications.
- **Member:** Any person meeting membership requirements.

Article 3

The gym facilities covered by the membership include the swimming pool, fitness center, sauna, jacuzzi, and steam room.

Article 4

The purpose of these instructions is:

- a. To enhance and strengthen family ties within the university community and foster interactions with other segments of society.
- b. To promote and support a sports culture.
- c. To facilitate access for members and users of the gym facilities, enabling them to benefit from the sports, social, and cultural activities managed by the Dean’s Office.

Article 5: Membership Requirements

- a. Good conduct and behavior.
- b. Free from contagious and infectious diseases.

c. Payment of the membership fees as outlined in Article (7). If the fees are not paid within two weeks, the application is considered void, requiring submission of a new application in accordance with these instructions.

d. Submission of a membership application to the Membership Committee (as formed in Article (6)), along with a personal photo of the applicant and any family members listed in the application. Usage of the gym facilities is permitted only after approval is granted.

Article 6

The President shall form a Membership Committee, chaired by the Dean, responsible for:

- a. Reviewing membership applications within two weeks of receiving the application form.
- b. Approving or deferring applications as deemed appropriate by the committee.
- c. Receiving suggestions and complaints, recommending solutions to the President.

Article 7

Membership fees are as follows, covering full access to all gym facilities:

- **University Staff and their Families:** 20 Jordanian Dinars per person per month.

Article 8

Membership fees for non-university members for specific courses (e.g., swimming, aerobics, rhythmic exercises) are as follows:

- Monthly subscription fee: 20 Jordanian Dinars
- Children's entry fee (one-time): 3 Jordanian Dinars
- Guest entry fee (one-time): 7 Jordanian Dinars

Article 9

The President shall appoint an accountant responsible for collecting annual and monthly membership fees, as well as fees for rhythmic courses, children and guest entries, and other charges. Collections will be deposited daily in the general fund of the Financial Affairs Unit.

Article 10

The accommodation fees for athletes are as follows:

a. **University Sports Camps:** 12 Jordanian Dinars per person, including accommodation and training facilities.

b. **National Teams, Sports Clubs, Official and Civil Bodies, and Jordanian Military Teams:** 20 Jordanian Dinars per person, including accommodation and training facilities.

Article 11

All members are equal in rights and obligations under these instructions, and the President has the authority to issue addenda to these instructions as needed.

Article 12

The President shall decide on any cases not explicitly addressed in these instructions.
