About

The university has adopted a set of transportation policies (click [here](#) for more details) that were designed to curtail the use of motor vehicles on campus, ensuring a secure and conducive learning environment. These policies align with government vehicle usage guidelines and encompass:

- Developing and executing a standardized transportation program for practical courses' students in collaboration with professors and faculty deans.
- Meeting internal and external transportation needs for the university community.
- Active participation in local community initiatives, election campaigns, and national events.
- Ensuring the university's vehicles remain operational through preventive and corrective maintenance, as well as vehicle cleaning and refueling.
- Providing maintenance services for King Abdulla University Hospital (KAUH's) vehicles.
- Offering training to Mechanical Engineering students in the Automotive Maintenance Division.
- Conducting internal competency exams for university vehicle drivers.
