The discussion centered on the following points:

- 1- Emphasizing the existence of depth in the principles of certain programming languages with practical projects suitable for the market like Android, event
- 2- Extending students' concepts and strengthening them from the practical side, with appropriate tracking work with students
- 3 - The bulk of interviews in companies for graduates is focused on their knowledge of databases and algorithms, and therefore the practical projects must be strengthened for that
- 4- Most companies that require new graduates are looking for deep graduates in specific fields (That is, he must have the ability to do certain tasks without the company needing to train him)
- 5- Computer Science Department competitions did not take into account the most requested programming languages in the market, such as Java and C Sharp

6- Helping the student to choose the programming language that suits him from his first year and making projects that enhance that until it is ready to be launched in the labor market

The most important thing was:

1- Carrying out a practical study to enhance the practical side including It caters to the market needs

2- Amending the information technology plans by setting 4 working hours at the rate of one hour at the end of each year so that It is a pre-requisite and compulsory for second-year subjects and so (4 hours can be taken from the graduation project)
