

Building Capacity in Water Integrity



Research objective:

To develop capacities of the different water stakeholder groups at different governance levels in the MENA region to improve transparency and accountability practices in water resources management.

Summary

Queen Rania A l Abdallah Center is part of a consortium in implementing the program activities and will be perform three tasks in particular, namely:

- to conduct a national study to identify the main water integrity risks in the Jordan.
- to host and provide the logistics for national trainings that is directed to various categories of national stakeholders (Civil Society, Women, Water Operators, High Rank Decision Makers).
- to conduct follow-up activities with alumni starting after the first national training is delivered.

Research Partners and Budget: Project PI: Prof. Hani AbuQdais, JUST.

Total Budget: 1,355,000 SEK

Research expected outcomes:

- National water risk integrity assessment including one day workshop.
- Hosting of National Water Integrity Trainings (5 three days workshops and 1 day alumni workshop).
- National Alumni follow-up activities.
