

ACETYLCHOLINE

CLASS: Cholinergic Agonist; Ophthalmic Agent, Miotic

INDICATIONS: Produces complete miosis in cataract surgery, keratoplasty, iridectomy, and other anterior segment surgery where rapid miosis is required

AVAILABLE DOSAGE FROM THE HOSPITAL:

DOSAGE:

- **Dosing: Adult**

To produce miosis: Intraocular: 0.5-2 mL of 1% injection (5-20 mg) instilled into anterior chamber before or after securing one or more sutures

- **Dosing: Geriatric**

Refer to adult dosing.

- **Dosing: Renal Impairment**

No dosage adjustment provided in manufacturer's labeling.

- **Dosing: Hepatic Impairment**

No dosage adjustment provided in manufacturer's labeling.

COMMON SIDE EFFECT: Frequency not defined.

Cardiovascular: Bradycardia, flushing, hypotension

Ocular: Clouding, corneal edema, decompensation

Respiratory: Dyspnea

Miscellaneous: Diaphoresis
