INDICATIONS: Treatment of vernal keratoconjunctivitis, vernal conjunctivitis, and vernal keratitis

DOSAGE:

- **Dosing: Adult**

Vernal conjunctivitis, keratitis: Ophthalmic: Instill 1-2 drops in eye(s) 4 times/day for up to 3 months

- **Dosing: Geriatric**

Refer to adult dosing.

- **Dosing: Renal Impairment**

No dosage adjustment provided in manufacturer's labeling. However, dosage adjustment unlikely due to low systemic absorption.

- **Dosing: Hepatic Impairment**

No dosage adjustment provided in manufacturer's labeling. However, dosage adjustment unlikely due to low systemic absorption.

COMMON SIDE EFFECT:

>10%: Local: Transient burning, stinging, discomfort
