Class: Antispasmodic Agent, Gastrointestinal

Indications: Treatment of irritable bowel syndrome

Available dosage form in the hospital:

MEBEVERINE HCL 135MG TAB

Trade Names:

Dosage:

Oral: 100-135 mg 3 times/day before meals

or

200 mg 2 times/day (modified release capsule)

Common side effect:

- 1.allergic or hypersensitivity reactions such as anaphylactic reactions
- 2.angioedema
- 3.face oedema
- 4.skin rash or rashes
- 5.urticaria
