

NAPHAZOLINE 0.1% EYE /DROPS

CLASS: Alpha1 Agonist; Imidazoline Derivative

INDICATIONS: Temporary relief of nasal congestion associated with the common cold, upper respiratory allergies, or sinusitis

AVAILABLE DOSAGE FROM THE HOSPITAL:

NAPHAZOLINE 0.1% EYE /DROPS

DOSAGE:

- **Dosing: Adult**

Nasal congestion (decongestant): Intranasal: 0.05%, instill 1-2 drops or sprays every 6 hours if needed; therapy should not exceed 3 days

- **Dosing: Geriatric**

Refer to adult dosing.

COMMON SIDE EFFECT: Frequency not defined.

Local: Transient stinging, nasal mucosa irritation, dryness, rebound congestion

Respiratory: Sneezing
