

SOLIFENACIN SUCCINATE

Class: Anticholinergic Agent

Indications: Treatment of overactive bladder with symptoms of urinary frequency, urgency, or urge incontinence

Available dosage form in the hospital: SOLIFENACIN SUCCINATE 5MG, 10MG FILM-COATED TABLET

Dosage:

-Overactive bladder: Oral: 5 mg once daily; if tolerated, may increase to 10 mg once daily

-Dosage adjustment with concomitant CYP3A4 inhibitors: Maximum solifenacin dose: 5 mg/day

Geriatric

Base dosing on renal/hepatic function.

Renal Impairment:

Use with caution in reduced renal function; $Cl_{cr} < 30$ mL/minute: Maximum dose: 5 mg/day

Hepatic Impairment:

Use with caution in reduced hepatic function:

Moderate (Child-Pugh class B): Maximum dose: 5 mg/day

Severe (Child-Pugh class C): Use is not recommended

Common side effect:

Gastrointestinal: Xerostomia (dose-related), constipation (dose-related)

Pregnancy Risk Factor: C
