

- **Health Centre**

JUST Health Centre (HC) in Irbid city was established in 1983 to provide medical care for students, faculty and staff. It is also a teaching centre that is recognized by Jordan Medical Council as a training centre for the residency program of family medicine.

- **Dental Teaching Centre**

The Dental Health Center in Irbid city trains future dentists and orthodontists. It also offers dental care for JUST faculty staff & students and for the local community.

- ☒ **Health & Life Insurance**

Health care is available for all students, the cost of which is included in the semester fees. It covers 100% of most services offered by the University Health Centers. The university provides free life insurance coverage for all students.

- ☒ **Housing**

The university offers a variety of services to help female students with their housing needs. Housing facilities are located on campus and shuttle services are available to ensure easy student access to campus locations. A downtown shuttle bus also provides free service Saturday through Thursday nights. Modern, centrally heated self-catering accommodation is available in rooms and studios for one or two students and are of different categories to provide the students with a choice of accommodation that suits their need. All rooms and studios are fully furnished at very reasonable prices. Facilities available include fully equipped shared kitchens, laundry, TV rooms, study rooms, visitor's reception halls, sport's halls public telephones bookshop, cafeteria, and supermarket.

- **Transportation**

There is a regular network of buses connecting the campus with Irbid city and surrounding towns. The university provides free transportation for trainee students in Irbid hospitals, clinics, and factories, and also in certain university celebrations and participation in national activities.

- **Food Services**

The University has four cafeterias for the students. Two are self-service and the other two serve a sit down lunch. The University Cafeterias provides hot meals, sandwiches, snacks, and hot and soft drinks at reasonable prices. The Cafeteria also serves breakfast. It opens from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Sunday through Thursday. Recently, (18) cottages had been constructed nearby the students gate, and are all rented as restaurants, coffee shops, barbershops, Internet cafés and bookshops.

- **The Book Store**

The book store on campus provides staff and students with all required academic text books at discounted prices.

- **The Post Office**

The post office carries out all postal services such as handling correspondence, printed matter, packages, deposited and paid postal money orders, permits, coupons and air mail.

- **The Bank**

Cairo-Amman Bank carries out all banking services to employee and students as well.

- **The Consumer's Shop**

It provides food, soft drinks, stationary, mobile services and other consumer's goods to university students and personnel at token prices.
